SUMMARY OF DETAILS: On the above date and time Pocono Mountain Regional Police responded to 188 Candle Drive for a report of a suspicious vehicle. Police arrived and the vehicle was gone from the location. A search of the area found a white F-350 just down the road which was reported stolen to State Police Lehighton. Police located a male inside a garage at 194 Candle Drive. The male was identified as Michael Smith and through investigation Police were able to link him to the stolen pick-up. Smith was also in the garage without the property owner permission and in possession of other stolen items and methamphetamine. Smith was taken into custody and taken to the Monroe County Correctional Facility pending arraignment.

SUMMARY OF DETAILS: On the above date and time, Pocono Mountain Regional Police and the Coolbaugh Township Vol. Fire Department were dispatched to 2962 Rustic Lane for a fully involved house fire. Upon arrival, contact was made with Amy Corwin. Corwin was attempting to enter the residence claiming that her boyfriend, Dellmont Pooley was still inside. The fire department was able to confirm that he was not within the residence. The investigation then revealed that Pooley and Corwin arrived at the residence to gather some belongings. While there, the two got into an argument. Corwin went to leave the residence and Pooley tried to stop her. Pooley then stated that he would burn the house down. Corwin left, but then came back a short time later to find the home engulfed. Pooley was located by Police several hours later and taken into custody. The fire was determined to have been intentionally set.
