SUMMARY OF DETAILS: On 10-13-2018, the Pocono Mountain Regional Police Responded to 8955 Deerfield Drive, Tobyhanna Pa. for an attempted burglary complaint. Upon arrival, police spoke with the victim who related the following. He was home watching television when he heard a knock at his door around 11pm. He did not answer the door and several minutes later, his door was kicked in. The suspects observed him and fled the area. Home surveillance video was pulled and it can be seen that 4 individuals wearing masks, carrying burglary tools and armed with a shotgun case the house and then kick the door in. The males then immediately flee the home. Pocono Mountain Regional Police are releasing still photos and a video and are asking residents to call tips into Detective Ryan Venneman. Police are also warning residents to be attentive, lock doors and call in any suspicious behavior.

SUMMARY OF DETAILS: On October 12th, 2018 at 2059 hours, Officers attempted to stop a gray Ford Explorer for a traffic violation at the "five points" intersection. The vehicle began to flee from police, on Route 940 at a high rate of speed, causing officers to terminate the pursuit. Officers then observed the vehicle leaving the Econo Stay Inn in Paradise Valley. The vehicle caused \$1400.00 dollars worth of property damage at the motel and began fleeing from police when they attempted to stop the vehicle again. Officers pursued the vehicle through the Pine Hill Estates development and north bound on Route 196 before terminating the pursuit because of the high rate of speed. As Officers checked the area they located the vehicle on Carriage Lane. The driver was taken into custody at this time without further incident. The driver of the vehicle, Lance A. Whitfield, refused a blood draw at the Monroe County DUI Center. He was evaluated by a drug recognition expert and found to be under the influence of cannabis.
